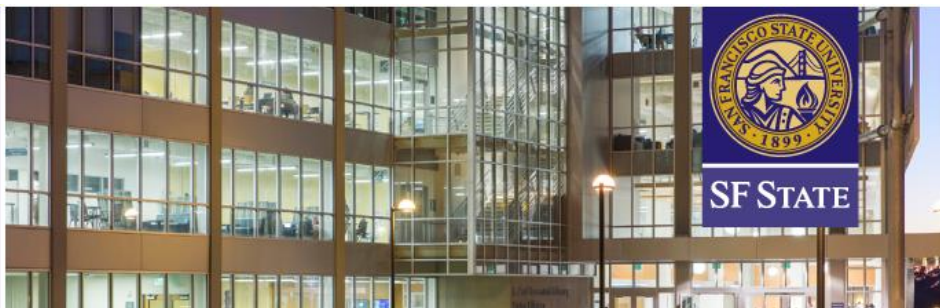

IGCSE (O-Levels) & GCE AS/A-Level Curriculum

Transcripts to Submit

- All IGCSE (O-Level) and GCE AS/A-Level examination results certificates. The “Candidate’s Statement of Results” is not accepted.
- Transcripts for years 9, 10, 11, and 12 (if no exams taken yet)

Grading scale

- SF State requires a minimum GPA of 2.50 (B- average)
 - ✓ Highest level exam for each subject is used for GPA calculation
(Example: Mathematics IGCSE exam completed one year, then the next year Mathematics GCE AS exam completed. Only AS level exam grade used in GPA calculation)
 - ✓ Earn a passing grade in at least 5 unique subjects
(In the example above, Mathematics would be counted as only 1 subject)

Get College Credit

- SF State awards general elective college credit for GCE AS and A Level examinations
- Must have a grade of E or better
- 4.5 credits for each unique AS-Level subject, 9 credits for each unique A-Level subject
- Request your official exam results be sent to SF State from the examination body, or have your high school make a certified copy of your original exam certificate and send it to SF State in a sealed envelope from your school.
